The Eighth Independent Forensic Axis

Executive Summary

A search of the AUTH_Judith-Cole document-set tag in the MCRO forensic database reveals that Cole is the PDF metadata author on 123 court documents spanning 86 cases across 31 of 81 defendant clusters. These documents are overwhelmingly “Findings and Order” and “Pet Commitment-Dfd Found Incompetent” filings — the exact document types at the center of the incompetency-order cloning findings reported in prior analyses.

The authorship data connects Cole to three distinct categories of forensically significant clusters: (1) all four CAS-11 synthetic clusters (Kraskey, Sharp, Terrell Johnson, Jacob Johnson); (2) two of the four Target 4 clusters (Wesley, Hassan); and (3) the case from which she was anomalously removed as prosecutor (Guertin, cluster 1570). When combined with the Cole-Prochazka attorney inversion documented in the parent report, this constitutes the eighth independent forensic axis binding the Target 4 network.

Finding 1: Cole's Authorship by the Numbers

Finding 2: Industrial Batch Filing Pattern

Cole's authorship is not distributed evenly. It concentrates into single-day batch events where dozens of court orders are created under the same metadata author on the same filing date:

The top two dates alone (Aug 31, 2021 and Feb 1, 2022) account for 42 of 123 documents — 34.1% of Cole's entire authored corpus, produced in just two days. Every one of these documents is a "Findings and Order" filing. This is not individual case adjudication. It is template-based mass production of court orders.

Finding 3: All Four CAS-11 Synthetic Clusters

The CAS-11 exhibit (Doc 48.0 in 25-cv-02670) identified four defendant clusters with characteristics of fabricated or recycled case identities: Kraskey (12 cases), Sharp (9), Terrell Johnson (9), and Jacob Johnson (7, as “Lane” equivalent). Cole authored documents in every single one:

The Kraskey and Sharp clusters are particularly striking: 7 documents each, all filed on a single date, all “Findings and Order.” These match the mass-production pattern of the MICHAEL HOWARD cluster (39 docs, 20 cases), which is Cole’s highest-volume authored cluster.

Finding 4: Target 4 Cross-Cluster Attorney Map

The Target 4 — Guertin (1570), Abdulkadir (674), Wesley (290), Lehmeyer (696) — are the four clusters that converge across seven independent forensic axes. Cole’s prosecution role and authorship now constitute the eighth:

** Cole does not author documents filed IN Guertin’s case or Abdulkadir’s case directly. She authors documents filed in Wesley and Hassan’s clusters. However, she is assigned as prosecutor to both Guertin and Abdulkadir cases — creating a dual-role presence (author in some Target 4 clusters, prosecutor in others).*

The Cole-Prochazka inversion mirrors across Guertin and Abdulkadir:

- Guertin: Cole goes INACTIVE, Prochazka is ACTIVE
- Abdulkadir (both CR cases): Cole stays ACTIVE, Prochazka goes INACTIVE

They swap roles between the two clusters. This oscillation pattern occurs nowhere else in the database.

Finding 5: Eight Independent Forensic Axes

The Target 4 clusters are now connected through eight independent forensic dimensions. Each axis was identified through a different analytical method, and each is independently verifiable from the database:

$C(80,4) = 1,581,580$ possible four-cluster combinations in the database. Only one combination produces convergence across all eight axes. That combination is Guertin, Abdulkadir, Wesley, and Lehmeyer.

Finding 6: Cole's Complete Structural Role

Synthesizing all findings, Cole occupies four distinct roles in the forensic network:

- **Prosecutor (878 cases):** The highest-volume prosecutor in the system. Present on 42.3% of all CR cases. Spans all 8 document-set groups in the DocSet forensic reports.
- **Document Author (123 documents, 31 clusters):** Creates mass-produced "Findings and Order" filings in batch events of up to 22 documents per day. These span the CAS-11 synthetic clusters and Target 4 clusters.
- **Inversion Anchor (1 case):** The sole instance in the database where Cole goes INACTIVE while her subordinate Prochazka stays ACTIVE — on Guertin's case specifically.
- **Cross-Cluster Oscillator (Guertin ↔ Abdulkadir):** Swaps active/inactive status with Prochazka between two Target 4 clusters. This mirrored assignment pattern occurs nowhere else in the database.

Cole is not a peripheral figure. She is structurally embedded at the intersection of the prosecution, document-production, and case-assignment systems that connect the Target 4 clusters. Her metadata authorship signature is on the synthetic infrastructure (Kraskey, Sharp, Johnson clusters). Her prosecution assignment binds the real cases (Guertin, Abdulkadir). And her anomalous removal from Guertin's case — the only case to discover and document these patterns — is the single most statistically improbable attorney event in the database.
