SENTENCE DETAILS: COUNT 1

Commit to Commissioner of Corrections

Ordered on December 11, 2023:

- Commit to Commissioner of Corrections at the MN Correctional Facility - Shakopee for 17 months.
Sentence is stayed for 3 years.
Credit for time served amount is 120 days.

This sentence consists of a minimum term of imprisonment equal to two-thirds of the total executed sentence, and a maximum supervised release term equal to one-third of the total executed sentence, unless the sentence is life or life without the possibility of release.

Monitoring

Ordered on December 11, 2023:

- Defendant is placed on supervised probation for 3 years, monitored by Hennepin County Community Corrections - Adult Field Services.

Conditions

Ordered on December 11, 2023:

Defendant must comply with the following conditions:

- Remain law-abiding
- Give a DNA sample when directed.
- Obtain Permission from Agent before leaving the State
- Do not use or possess firearms, ammunition or explosives
- No alcohol/controlled substance use With the exception of prescribed medications. Testing as determined by probation. If there is a positive test, a refusal to submit to testing, or tampering of any kind with the sample or the test, probation may require you to enter treatment and/or complete a substance use disorder assessment with probation as collateral and follow all recommendations.
- Take medications in the prescribed dosage and frequency
- Provide List of Prescribed Medications to Probation Officer
- Sign all releases of information
- Cognitive skill training
- Follow recommendations of evaluation
- Follow all State and Federal criminal laws.
- Contact your probation officer as directed.
- Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you have contact with law enforcement.
- Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you are charged with any new crime.
- Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you change your address, employment, or telephone number.
- Cooperate with the search of your person, residence, vehicle, workplace, property, and things as directed by your probation officer.
- Sign releases of information as directed.

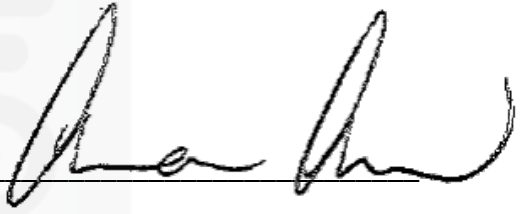
